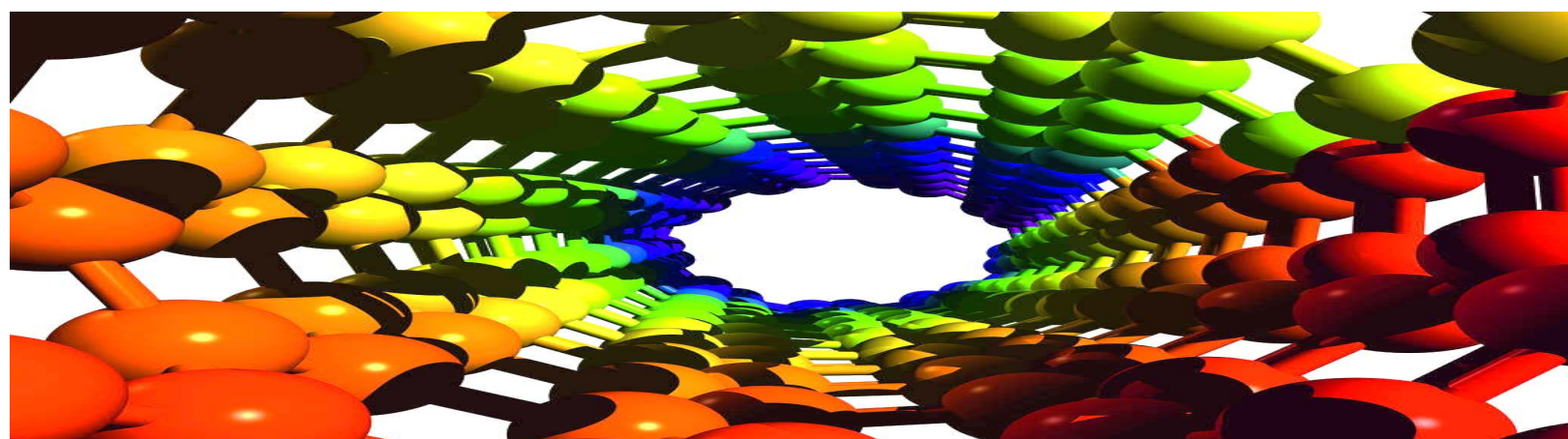


SMART POLYMER COMPOSITE MATERIALS AND STRUCTURES

- Cumulative GPA of at least **3.00**
